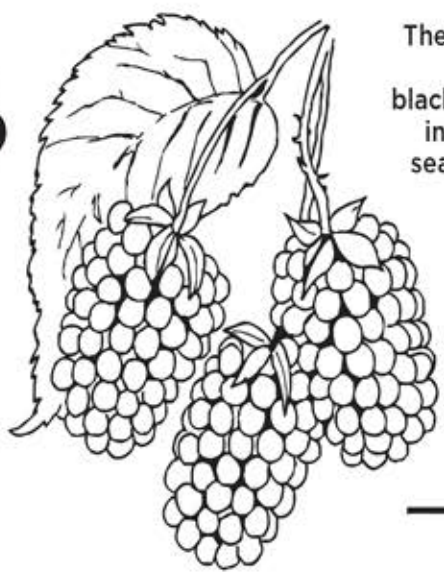

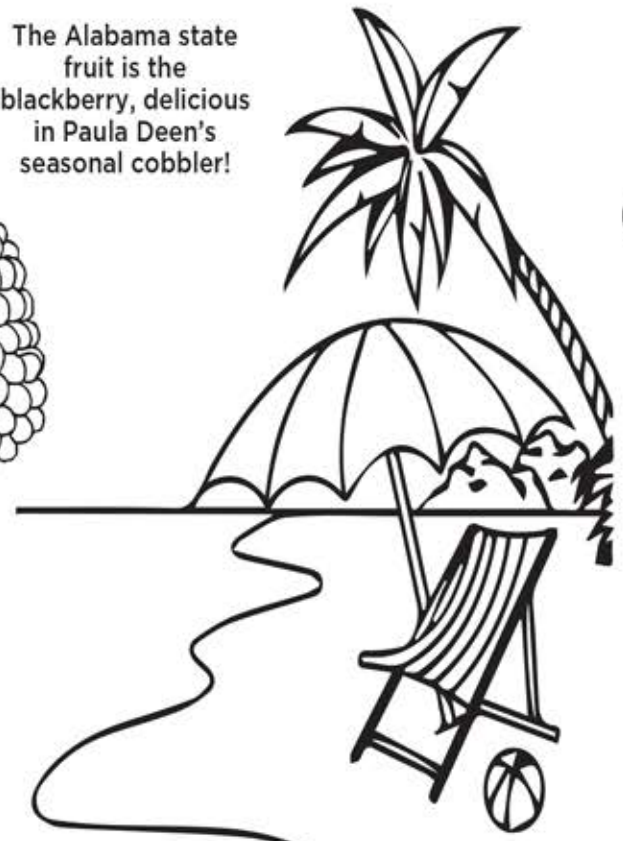


The Alabama state fruit is the blackberry, delicious in Paula Deen's seasonal cobbler!

Located on the Gulf of Mexico, the Gulf Coast receives 6.4 million visitors a year.

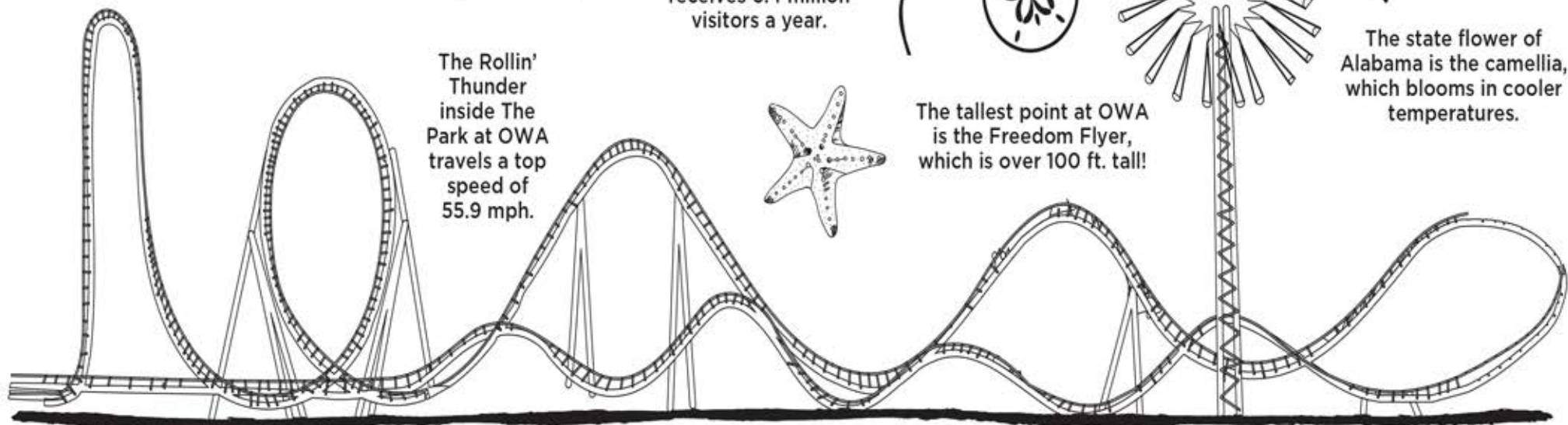


The first Paula Deen's Family Kitchen opened April 27, 2015 in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee.



The state flower of Alabama is the camellia, which blooms in cooler temperatures.

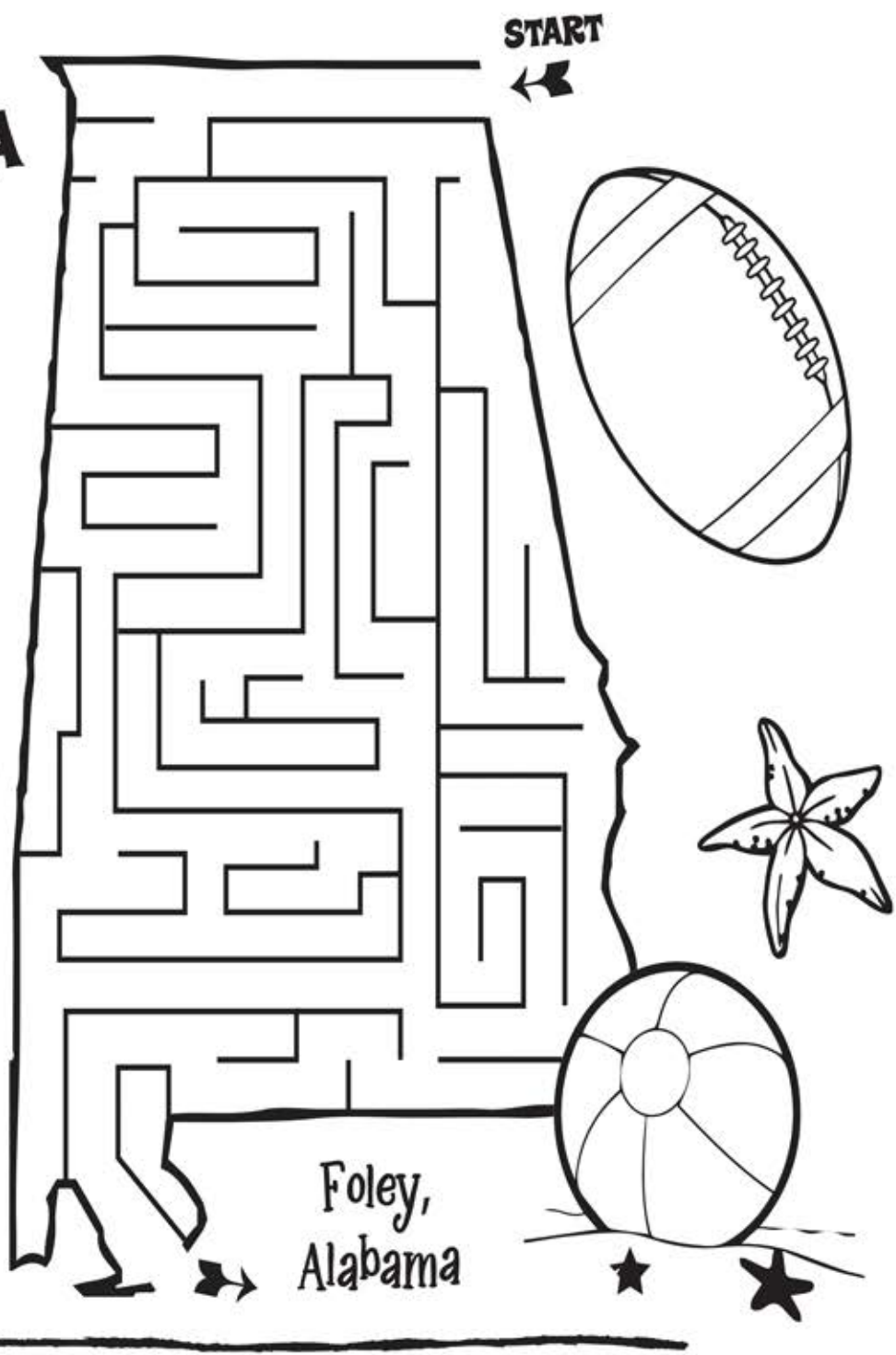
The Rollin' Thunder inside The Park at OWA travels a top speed of 55.9 mph.



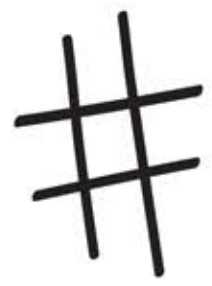
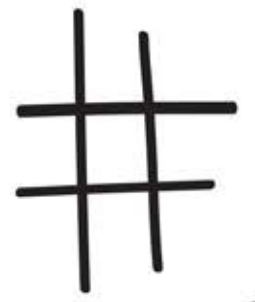
The tallest point at OWA is the Freedom Flyer, which is over 100 ft. tall!

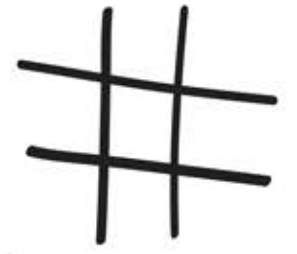
