

OFFICIAL RULES

By participating, participants agree to be bound by the following official rules and all decisions of Foley Holdings LLC dba OWA Parks and Resort ("Sponsor"):

1. Eligibility: OWA Summer Games 2026 ("Competition") is open to groups of five individuals each of which are aged 18 years or older at the time of entry (each eligible group hereinafter referred to collectively as a "Team"). Each individual is hereinafter referred to as a "Participant." OWA team members are not eligible to participate.

2. Registration and Agreement to Rules: Registration is online at [\[insert link\]](#) and requires online payment of a per Team entry fee of \$100. Upon registering all Team Participants must: (a) agree to be fully unconditionally bound by these rules, and (b) represent and warrant that the Participant meets the eligibility requirements. In addition, the Participant must agree to accept the decisions of SPONSOR as final and binding as it relates to all aspects of the Competition. Registration opens on July 22, 2026, and closes on the earlier of (c) reaching the maximum number of teams, or (d) August 23, 2026.

3. Competition Details:

A. Teams must compete in person at OWA in Foley, Alabama on Saturday, August 29, 2026, for points in the following six activities:

1. Bucket Brigade Dash (Water Transfer Challenge)

Distance: 50 ft (One way)

Participants Per Round: 5

Competition Type: Individual

Objective: Race against up to four other teams to be the first team to raise your ping pong ball to the top of your team's cylinder and stop the clock.

How to Play:

- Up to five teams will compete at a time, with only one racer from each team.
- At the start signal, use the provided bowl to scoop water from your team's bucket.
- Carry the water to your team's clear cylinder and pour it in.
- Continue racing back and forth until the water raises the ping pong ball to the top of the cylinder.
- Retrieve the ping pong ball, race back to the starting line, and press your team's finish button to stop the clock.

Rules:

- The designated racer must remain in their designated lane at all times.
- All teammates and spectators must remain outside the race area.
- No player substitutions are permitted during the event.
- The designated racer must hit their team's button to stop their time.
- Participants must use the provided bowl to transfer water.
- Spilling water is expected... just keep running!
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or intentionally interfering with another competitor will result in disqualification.
- Officials' decisions are final.

Scoring: Each team's official completion time will be recorded. After all teams in your division have competed, points will be awarded based on the OWA Summer Games scoring system below.

Top 5 (OVERALL) Fastest Times

- 1st Place = 50 Points
- 2nd Place = 40 Points

- 3rd Place =30 Points
- 4th Place =20 Points
- 5th Place = 10 Points
- All other teams will receive 5 points participating

2. Knights of OWA (Pedestal Joust)

Participants Per Round: 2

Competition Type: Individual

Objective: Outlast your opponent by remaining on your pedestal while attempting to knock them off using the provided jousting pole.

How to Play:

1. Two competitors will face off on elevated pedestals.
2. At the start signal, use the provided padded jousting pole to challenge your opponent.
3. Defend your balance while attempting to knock your opponent off their pedestal.
4. Winners advance through the tournament bracket until a champion is crowned.

Rules:

- A competitor is eliminated when any part of their body touches the ground below their pedestal.
- Competitors must remain on their own pedestal at all times.
- Only the provided jousting pole may be used.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, dangerous play, or intentional contact outside of normal jousting will result in immediate disqualification.
- The winner of each match advances to the next round of the bracket.
- Officials' decisions are final.

Scoring: This event is conducted as a single-elimination bracket. Once the bracket is complete, points will be awarded as follows:

- 1st Place – 50 Points
- 2nd Place – 40 Points
- 3rd & 4th Place – 30 Points
- All other teams receive 10 Points for participating

3. Ring the Rival (Human Ring Toss)

Platform Height: 10 ft

Competition Type: Individual

Objective: Score the most points by successfully tossing inflatable rings onto opposing team members and designated scoring platforms.

How to Play:

1. One participant from each team will compete from the elevated throwing platform.
2. Each competitor receives four (4) standard rings and one (1) bonus ring.
3. Toss your rings at opposing team members and the designated scoring platforms below.
4. The competitor with the highest overall total score wins.

Point Values:

- Level 1 Target – 10 Points
- Level 2 Target – 20 Points
- Level 3 Target – 30 Points
- Level 4 Target – 40 Points
- Ring an Opposing Player – +10 Bonus Points
- Bonus Ring – Doubles the total points earned during this game.

Rules:

- Each competitor receives four standard rings and one bonus ring.
- Rings landing on a scoring platform earns the corresponding point value.

- Successfully ringing, an opposing player earns an additional 10-point bonus.
- Ringing your own teammate results in a deduction equal to the points on the level the teammate is standing on.
- The bonus ring may only be used once and doubles the points scored during this game if it successfully lands on an opposing team member. If it lands on your own teammate points will be deducted based on the level the teammate is standing on.
- Teammates standing in the different levels may not move or make any motions to obstruct the tossed rings from landing on them.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or intentionally interfering with another competitor will result in disqualification.
- Officials' decisions are final.

Scoring:

- Each competitor's points will be totaled at the end of their round.
- After all competitors in each division have participated, teams will receive points based on the official OWA Summer Games scoring system.

4. Tower of Triumph (Team Stack)

Teams Per Round: 5

Team Size: 5 Participants

Objective: Work together to build your tower as quickly as possible using only the ropes provided and lifting device.

How to Play:

1. Up to Five teams will compete at one time.
2. Each team must use the provided ropes and lifting devices to move and stack the blocks.
3. Team members may only control the lifting device by using the attached ropes—no hands may touch the blocks once the challenge begins.
4. Once your tower is successfully completed, one team member must race to the finish button to stop the clock.

Rules:

- All team members must remain in their designated competition area.
- Blocks may only be moved using the provided lifting device and ropes.
- If the tower falls before the finish button is pressed, the team must rebuild the entire tower before stopping the clock.
- The official time stops only when the tower is complete, and the finish button has been pressed.
- If the tower collapses before the team's button is pushed they must start back over.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or intentionally interfering with another competitor will result in disqualification.
- Officials' decisions are final.

Scoring:

- Each team's official completion time will be recorded.
- After all teams in the division have competed, points will be awarded based on the fastest recorded times:

- 1st Place – 50 Points
- 2nd Place – 40 Points
- 3rd Place – 30 Points
- 4th Place – 20 Points
- 5th Place & Beyond – 10 Points

5. Hamster Ball Havoc (Water Race)

Course: Pier to Main OWA Bridge and Return

Participants Per Round: 1

Competition Type: Individual

Objective: Navigate the course and complete the race in the fastest time possible.

How to Play:

1. One participant from each team will compete.
2. Referees will load players into water ball.
3. When the referee hits the start signal, enter the water in the water ball and begin the course.
4. Race from the starting point, to the designated area and then return to the starting point.
5. Complete the course as quickly as possible while remaining within the designated race lane.

Rules:

- Races may be conducted one participant at a time or head-to-head, depending on the event schedule.
- Competitors must remain within their designated race lane at all times.
- Shoes, jewelry, watches, and other sharp objects are not permitted inside the inflatable ball.
- Participants must follow all instructions from event officials before, during, and after the race.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or intentionally interfering with another competitor will result in disqualification.
- Officials' decisions are final.

Scoring:

- Each competitor's official completion time will be recorded.
- After all teams in each division have competed, points will be awarded based on the fastest recorded times:

- 1st Place – 100 Points
- 2nd Place – 80 Points
- 3rd Place – 60 Points
- 4th Place – 40 Points
- 5th Place & Beyond – 20 Points

6. Chariot Race

Course: Start at OWA Store, head towards OWA Theater, over to the Island and back to finish at OWA Store.

Participants Per Round: 4 Teams

Team Size: 5 Participants (3 Riders, 2 Water Blasters)

Objective: Work together to complete the course in the fastest adjusted time while your Water Blasters soak the opposing teams.

How to Play:

- Three riders will complete the course using adult Big Wheels.
- Riders must come to a complete stop at each designated exchange station before switching with the next teammate.
- Two designated Water Blasters will spray opposing teams throughout the race from their assigned blasting zones.
- Once all riders have crossed the finish line, event officials will inspect each team's riders.
- The team whose color is most visible on an opposing team's riders will earn a 5-second deduction from their final race time.
- The team with the fastest adjusted time wins.

Rules:

- Riders must remain on the designated race course at all times.
- Riders must come to a complete stop at each exchange station before switching participants.
- Water Blasters must remain within their designated blasting zones.

- Only the official event water blasters may be used.
- Water Blasters may only spray opposing teams.
- Bumping, pushing, blocking, or intentional contact is prohibited.
- All participants must follow instructions from event officials.
- Officials' decisions are final.

B. Time Bonus

- At the completion of each race, officials will determine which team's color is most prominently displayed on an opposing team's three riders.
- That team will receive a 5-second deduction from its final race time.
- Only one bonus will be awarded per race.

4. Disqualification: If a Participant is found in Sponsor's sole discretion to be in violation of any of these official rules, he or she will be immediately disqualified from the Competition. Additional grounds for disqualification include, without limitation, (i) excessive use of alcoholic beverages or public intoxication, (ii) use of illegal controlled substances, (iii) foul, abusive, or unacceptable language or any language causing a disturbance, (iv) fighting and/or disorderly conduct, and (v) theft, dishonesty, cheating, or any act involving moral turpitude. Sponsor, in its sole discretion, shall determine whether a single participant or an entire Team is disqualified. If the entire Team is not disqualified, then the remaining participants of the Team may proceed with the remaining activities, if any.

5. Winner Selection and Notification: Winners will be selected based upon the points earned by the Teams. Winners will be publicly announced upon completion of all six above-described competition activities on Saturday, August 29, 2026.

6. Prizes: Prizes are as follows:

A. Each teammate on the Team with the highest total number of points upon completion of all activities ("1st place Team") will receive (i) one OWA Season Pass to Tropic Falls (valued at \$269.99), (ii) one OWA Swag bag filled with goodies from OWA, Tropic Falls & Summer Games, and (iii) one 1st place award (medal).

B. Each teammate on the Team with the second highest total number of points upon completion of all activities ("2nd place Team") will receive (i) two Tickets to Tropic Falls (valued at \$69.99 per), (ii) one OWA

Swag bag filled with goodies from OWA, Tropic Falls & Summer Games, and (iii) one 2nd place award (medal).

C. Each teammate on the Team with the third highest total number of points upon completion of all activities ("3rd place Team") will receive (i) one Ticket to Tropic Falls (valued at \$69.99), (ii) one \$10 gift card redeemable at Ben's Pretzel at OWA, (iii) one \$10 gift card redeemable at Sweet Tooth at OWA, (iv) one OWA Swag bag filled with goodies from OWA, Tropic Falls & Summer Games, and (v) one 3rd place award (medal).

7. Rights Granted to Sponsor: By entering this Competition, Participant understands and agrees that Sponsor, anyone acting on behalf of Sponsor, and Sponsor's licensees, successors, and assigns, shall have the right, where permitted by law, to print, publish, broadcast, distribute, and use in any media now known or hereafter developed, in perpetuity and throughout the World, without limitation, Participant's entry, name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, image, statements about the Competition, and biographical information for news, publicity, information, trade, advertising, public relations, and promotional purposes without any further compensation, notice, review, or consent.

8. Restrictions: Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Competition should a virus, bug, non-authorized human intervention, fraud, dangerous or severe weather or other cause beyond Sponsor's control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, or proper conduct of the Competition. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Participant who violates these official rules or exhibits any reasonable grounds for disqualification.

9. ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE, LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: By participating, Participant represents that Participant has read these official rules and is familiar with the described activities and finds and accepts the Competition as suitable and safe for Participant's participation. Participant understands and acknowledges that there are certain inherent risks of physical injury and potential dangers associated with the Competition, including without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis, loss of life, emotional distress and/or disfigurement resulting from, without limitation, movements (for example, rotations, spinning), use of rarely used muscles, compression and extension of bones and muscles, striking or hitting the floor, an object, or other persons, being struck or hit by other persons, physical impacts, failure to follow instructions (collectively and individually, "Risks"). Participant expressly accepts and assumes sole responsibility for the Risks and other undefined, not readily foreseeable, or presently unknown risks and dangers associated with the competition. Participant represents and certifies that Participant is willing to assume the risk of any medical and/or physical condition of Participant's being re-injured, aggravated, or triggered by participating in the Competition. Participant further agrees to RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Sponsor, its subsidiaries, affiliates, tenants, advertising and promotion agencies, partners, representatives, agents, successors, assigns, employees, officers, and directors from any liability, illness, injury, death, loss, litigation, claim, or damage that may occur, directly or indirectly, whether caused by negligence or not, from Participant's participation in the Competition and/or his/her acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize or any portion thereof.

10. Disputes: Competition decisions are made at the discretion of Sponsor and all decisions are final and binding in all respects. In the event a dispute arises concerning these official rules or the way the Competition is carried out, the laws of the United States and the State of Alabama apply, without respect

to conflict of law doctrines. As a condition of participating in this Competition, Participant agrees that any and all disputes that cannot be resolved between the parties, and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Competition, shall be resolved individually, without resorting to any form of class action. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances shall the Participant be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waives all rights to, punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including reasonable attorney's fees, other than the Participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (i.e. costs associated with entering this Competition). Participant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.

11. Health and Safety: Participants are responsible for their own health and well-being during the Competition. Sponsor is not responsible for any injuries or health issues that may arise during the Competition. Participants should ensure they are in good health and physically capable of participating in the Competition. If a Participant feels unwell at any point during the Competition, they should notify a member of the Sponsor staff immediately and may need to withdraw from the Competition. Sponsor is not responsible for any forfeiture of the Competition due to a Participant becoming sick or unable to continue.

12 Fair Play: Participants are expected to play fairly and respect other Participants. Harassment, intimidation, or any form of unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification.

13. Interferences: Participants are not allowed to interfere with other Participants in any way. Any attempts to distract or hinder other Participants will result in immediate disqualification.

14. Responsibility for Personal Belongings: Participants are responsible for their own personal belongings. Sponsor will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items.

15. Modification of Rules: Sponsor reserves the right to modify these official rules at any time, without prior notice. Any modifications will be effective immediately upon posting. Participants are encouraged to check the website regularly to stay informed of any changes. For example, the date may be subject to change due to inclement weather or the location of an activity may be subject to change.
